Gather up your like-new / new books for Coffee Creek, Oregon's only women's prison. The book drive enriches the collection of books available to the women incarcerated at Coffee Creek, as well as the libraries in Oregon's other correctional facilities.

LIBRARY REQUIREMENTS:

Format: Hard cover and soft cover books and books on CD. NO books on tape or magazines.

Do you want to volunteer? (Yes, you do!)

This important service project could not occur without the support of OWLS members, and we encourage you to sign up to do one or more of the following:

- **Collect books** at your home or office. Donors will bring their books to your home or office from May 1 through May 12, and books will be picked by transporters between May 15 through May 19.
- **Transport books from Portland collection sites** to the sorting location (TBD PORTLAND) between May 15-May 19.
- **Transport books from non-Portland collection sites** to the sorting location (TBD) or to a non-Portland location between May 1-12. This will be organized better once we know where the non-Portland collection sites are and who is available to transport books. Sometimes volunteers who collect books at their home or office deliver the books directly to Coffee Creek.
- **Sort books** at a sorting party Sunday **May 21, 2023**.
- **Deliver books** to Coffee Creek. You will pick up banker boxes of books from (sorting site) and deliver them to the prison, which is in Wilsonville. We also need deliverers outside of Portland.
